Dr Brittberg's research has been focused on cartilage repair and with main focus on cartilage regeneration with in vitro expanded autologous chondrocytes. Today the main interest is the European Connective Tissue Engineering Centre a collaboration between the Institution of Orthopaedics, Göteborg University and the institution of polymer technology, Chalmers Technical University. Dr Brittberg has also a research collaboration with Virginia Tech in USA on biotribology in cartilage and osteoarthritis
